The Editorial Board of Youth and Generation Studies (YGS) hereby calls on social sciences experts and within this, those specialized in youth studies and intergenerational relationships and related disciplines, to publish studies and articles in the journal's 2024 issues.

The editors are primarily interested in analyses related to the lifestyles, situations, and mindsets of youth and various generations, as well as writings that deal with the theoretical and methodological approaches of youth and generational research and the presentation of social science discourses. In line with the journal's most important goal of providing a comprehensive picture of new generations, the editors are also open to writings that sensitively reflect on current dilemmas in addition to contemporary issues. Youthhood consists of the most dynamically changing stage of life, and as a result, the journal also provides space for those articles that focus on current affairs, and whose scientific investigation can only take place at a later time.

In the 2024 issues of Youth and Generation Studies, submissions from young researchers, doctoral students, and university students are also welcomed.

The journal's editors reserve the right to decide on the acceptance and subsequent release for evaluation of submitted manuscripts. Every manuscript entered will receive confirmation of receipt. The journal will publish manuscripts in the following categories: original scientific



studies, book reviews or recommendations, reports on scientific events, research results, data, conference announcements, and more. In the case of submitting a scientific manuscript, the review process will consist of a double-blind professional review; manuscripts are evaluated by at least two reviewers. Given the double-blind peer review system, please send manuscripts in a format that does not reveal the author's name, institutional affiliation, e-mail address, or self-reference that enables identification (e.g. "see in my previous study...").

The journal only accepts papers in English. The minimum length of publications is 40,000 characters for studies, and 15,000 gross (i.e. including spaces) characters for book reviews. Any other format should be between a minimum gross number of 10,000 characters, and a maximum of 30,000. When entering submissions, please indicate the following information concerning the author: academic degree, job position, workplace and its address, and e-mail address. All work entered (and the respective bibliographies) must meet the formal requirements of Youth and Generation Studies which can be found here: https://ygs.hu

Taking into account these stipulations, the editors decide whether to accept a manuscript, send it back for revision, or reject it.
